Freedom Beat, praised by *La Provence* as "a game of arrangement of instruments and sounds," is known for its theatrical flair, creative use of self-made instruments, and fusion of diverse percussion styles. With training in physical theater, the ensemble enhances its performances with dramatic intensity. International appearances include the Festival d'Avignon Off (2012, 2013), OzAsia Festival (2018), and Western Arts Alliance Annual Conference (2019).

"Fifties" is a Sound Theater piece guiding audiences on a sonic journey from 1950s Taiwan to 2050. Blending storytelling, percussion, live foley, music, radio drama, and IRCAM's Spat Revolution technology for immersive binaural sound, the show weaves sci-fi with vintage aesthetics into a uniquely inventive auditory experience.

NanaFormosa Percussion Duo was founded in 2009 by two Taiwanese percussionists: Yu-Ying Chang and Ya-Hsin Cheng. In 2009, they attended the International Percussion Competition of Luxembourg and won the third prize of percussion duo. Their repertoire contains contemporary music, theater music, their own arrangements for the keyboard works of Bach, Rameau, Scarlatti, Ravel, Debussy, Bartok and Guastavino, duo concerto with percussion, wind ensemble and orchestra.

"The Day in Gad-Avia" is an immersive concert that blends percussion, sound, visuals, and interactive technology to create a dreamlike journey through a fictional floating town. It exists between nature and civilisation, between city and countryside.

MANAGONA centers on the intersection of music, sound art, and visual technology, creating a distinctive contemporary musical experience through interdisciplinary collaboration. Blending acoustic percussion with electronic elements, their music weaves intricate rhythms and explores the human encounter with the abyss, expressed through minimalist abstraction.

Their 40-minute touring program offers a multi-sensory journey, inviting audiences to connect physically or emotionally with the music. Improvised in its origins, MANAGONA's sound merges organic and technological textures, bridging experimental styles and a sleek, techno-inspired aesthetic. The result is a versatile experience—suitable for dance, introspection, or immersive listening—that resonates on multiple sensory levels.

"Falling into Dreams," a newly conceived Peking Opera music-theatre work that departs from elaborate stage design and costuming, opting instead for a refined, tour-friendly format that highlights the essence of musical drama. The Peking Opera performer has crafted an entirely new script by weaving together texts from *The Book of Songs*—China's oldest anthology of poetry—and the classic Peking Opera repertoire *A Dream in the Boudoir*.

Set in the war-torn era of the Three Kingdoms, 1,800 years ago, the story unfolds through the virtuosic performance of four musicians who narrate the drama through music, revealing the timeless wounds that war inflicts upon humanity.

Flutist HUA Pei is devoted to interdisciplinary musical theatre. *"On the Mind of Transience"* is inspired by the ancient legend The Legend of the White Snake and explores the question: if life could be lived again, would the characters choose a different path? Combining flute performance, acting, and dance, Hua joins forces with renowned Taiwanese Peking Opera artist Chu An-Li. Together, they portray the two female protagonists, with Singaporean composer NG Kangkee creating a musical score that allows the characters to transcend time and space.

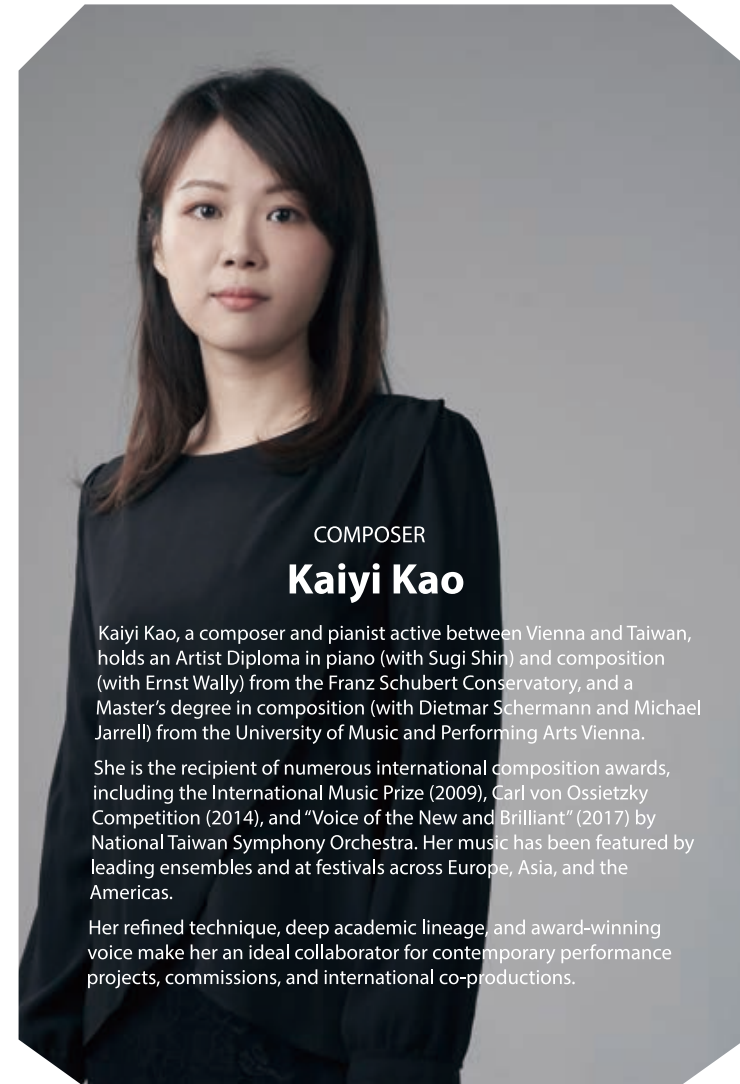

Kaiyi Kao, a composer and pianist active between Vienna and Taiwan, holds an Artist Diploma in piano (with Sugi Shin) and composition (with Ernst Wally) from the Franz Schubert Conservatory, and a Master's degree in composition (with Dietmar Schermann and Michael Jarrell) from the University of Music and Performing Arts Vienna.

She is the recipient of numerous international composition awards, including the International Music Prize (2009), Carl von Ossietzky Competition (2014), and "Voice of the New and Brilliant" (2017) by National Taiwan Symphony Orchestra. Her music has been featured by leading ensembles and at festivals across Europe, Asia, and the Americas.

Her refined technique, deep academic lineage, and award-winning voice make her an ideal collaborator for contemporary performance projects, commissions, and international co-productions.

Respond to the Improvisation of Life

In classical music, the German term *Liederzyklus* refers to a series of songs that are designed to be performed in a sequence which forms a story. Based on this idea, "*Liederzyklus*" consists of three artists who initiate conversations with their musical instruments and their bodies. They reflect both the moment and the eternity of music and dance through addressing the delicate lights of lives. They are like the members of a chamber music who all begin performing at the same starting point and speed but then improvise within a rehearsed construction and limited form.
