

Since 2020, the Innovation Center for Art and Technology at National Taiwan University of Arts has been promoting the creation of fulldome projection content. This includes guiding students in their creative projects through courses, collaborating with industry for academic-industry partnerships, and expanding into rural areas. The range of creative works is diverse, encompassing animation, AI-generated content, live-action filming, music creation, dance creation, and more.

Our school currently has a 5m diameter inflatable dome space that is easy to move, quickly assemble, and disassemble, making it ideal for short-term events. Additionally, we have a 4m diameter dome space constructed from cardboard, aimed at creating a sustainable and ecofriendly immersive space. By designing corresponding cardboard sizes and using special assembly techniques, we achieve a cost-effective DIY dome installation that also serves as an installation art piece.
